The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved to be effective 6<sup>th</sup> June 2014 by the Class Rules Sub committee.

### Rule F 4 Note (2) – Hull Templates

Amendment: Add to the end of the existing rule

Only templates from a supplier  $\Theta$  approved by ISAF  $\Theta$  and the ICA shall be used for hull measurement.

#### Rule F 3.5. - Mandatory Mast Fittings

Amendment: Add to the end of the existing rule

(11) A device to ensure compliance with C.10.4 (b) (4) if the mainsail halyard system itself does not do so.\_unless the mainsail halyard is set on a lock or toothrack..

#### Rule G.2.1

Amendment: add to the end of the existing rule (c) Jibs shall be measured with the luff wire removed.

# Rule G.3.2. & G.4.2 - Mainsail & Jib Materials Amendment:

G.3.2 MATERIALS

- (a) **Body of the sail** permitted material is white **woven ply** with polyester fibres The ply fibres shall be of polyester.
- (b) Battens may be made of any material.
- (c) **Primary** and **secondary reinforcement** permitted material is white **woven ply** with polyester fibres

Rule G.3.3(e) & G.4.2 - Mainsail & Jib Construction

**Amendment**: delete from the existing rule "which may be made from a woven ply thinner than that of the body of the sail,"

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# Rule G.5.1 - Spinnaker Materials Amendment:

### G.5.1 MATERIALS

- (a) The **ply** fibres shall be of polyester or nylon. Body of the sail permitted material is **woven ply** with polyester or nylon fibres.
- (b) **Primary** and **secondary reinforcement** permitted material is **woven ply** with polyester or nylon fibres.
